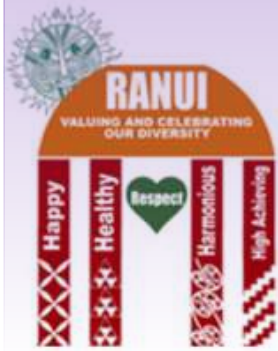


Twk Market Day
